

WOW! WONDERS ON WHEELS! MUSEUM ON THE MOVE

Wonders on Wheels is an educational RV equipped with a museum exhibit. We travel all over the state, delivering educational programming to rural and under-served communities.

In our 2025 exhibit, “Eight Sites, One History,” we explore the complex history of New Mexico. This exhibit is developed in partnership with New Mexico Historic Sites.



The RV is 38-feet long, 9 feet wide, and 15 feet tall.

We require a firm, fairly level surface for parking.

Parking must allow for safe access to our passenger-side doors.

We prefer to park within 100 feet of a standard electrical outlet. Please check to make sure outlets are functional.



For school visits, groups of **30 students (or less)** visit the RV for our 45 minute program. Once assembled, students are divided into sub-groups of two. One sub-group tours the RV while the other sub-group engages in an educational activity outside the RV. After 20 minutes, the two groups switch. The activity can be delivered outside or inside, depending on the weather.

For visits to libraries and special events, members of the public are invited to participate in the exhibit and the outside activity at their own pace.
